



Teresa Johnson Memorial Scholarship Application Process

The **Teresa Johnson Memorial Scholarship Fund** has been established with the Clark County Community Foundation, Inc. (CCCF) and will annually award one scholarship to an eligible, qualified and selected Applicant.

For the 2023 Scholarship Cycle, the amount to be awarded is \$400.

To Apply:

1. Complete and submit the attached **Teresa Johnson Memorial Scholarship Fund Application** form (pages 3-5) by **March 31, 2023** to the CCCF. Attach additional information as required or as necessary to complete the Application in its entirety.
2. **Primary selection criteria** will be based on the Applicant's ability to meet the following criteria:
 - a. Applicant is graduating with a High School diploma in the current scholarship cycle;
 - b. Applicant has a primary residence address that is located within Clark County, WI;
 - c. Applicant has applied for admittance and has been, or is in the process of being accepted, for the Fall semester (following high school graduation) at a Wisconsin-based college, technical college or other institution of higher education pursuing a degree or certification in an established course of study;
 - d. Preference may be given, by the Foundation's annual Scholarship Selection Committee, to the Applicant's interest and / or participation in any of the following areas or items:
 - i. FFA Programs
 - ii. 4-H Programs
 - iii. Raising and or showing horses
 - iv. Showmanship awards or competition
 - v. Leadership skills / offices held
 - vi. Volunteer efforts and / or participation
 - vii. Pursuing further education in the field of Education and or Accounting.
3. **Additional consideration** will be given to the Applicant's response to the following:
 - a. participation in school and community activities,
 - b. two (2) letters of recommendation – one from each of the following:
 - i. an educator within your school district,
 - ii. a non-family, non-school affiliated adult community member who knows you personally,
 - c. completed essay (*no more than 250 words*) describing your most meaningful experiences or achievements. Emphasis on topics in item 2 (d) above preferred.
 - d. most recent high school transcript signed by the school's guidance counselor or principal.



Payment of award to the successful Scholarship Recipient:

- a. Once proof of enrollment to the four-year college / university OR technical school program (as stated in their application) is received from the successful scholarship recipient, payment will be mailed shortly thereafter.
 - b. This is a one-time scholarship award. Previous scholarship recipients are not eligible to receive additional amounts from this Scholarship Fund.
 - c. Scholarship awards are not retroactive and may not be credited to semesters already completed.
 - d. The successful applicant will be notified of their scholarship award in May 2023.
