

# Harry and Esther King Memorial Scholarship Application Process

The **Harry and Esther King Memorial Scholarship Fund** has been established with the Clark County Community Foundation, Inc. (CCCF) and will annually award at least one scholarship to an eligible, qualified and selected Neillsville (WI) High School graduating student.

For the 2023 Scholarship Cycle, the Scholarship(s) to be awarded are \$300 each.

# To Apply:

- 1. Complete and submit the attached Harry and Esther King Memorial Scholarship Fund Application form (pages 3-5) by March 31, 2023 to the CCCF. Attach additional information as required or as necessary to complete the Application in its entirety.
- **2. Primary selection criteria** will be based on the Applicant's ability to meet the following criteria:
  - **a.** Applicant is a current year senior graduating from Neillsville High School, Neillsville, WI.
  - **b.** Applicant has a grade point average of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
  - **c.** Applicant has applied for admittance and has been, or is in the process of being accepted, for the Fall semester (following high school graduation) at a college / university OR a technical school program.
  - **d.** Applicant has declared a course of study, preferably in the field of Agriculture or Education.
- 3. Additional consideration will be given to the Applicant's response to the following:
  - **a.** participation in school and community activities,
  - **b.** two (2) letters of recommendation one from each of the following:
    - i. an educator in the Neillsville (WI) School District,
    - **ii.** a non-family, non-school affiliated adult community member who knows you personally,
  - c. completed essay (no more than 250 words) describing in their own words,
    - i. their most meaningful achievements (emphasis on Education or Agriculture experiences if applicable),
    - **ii.** a summary of their future goals and how this Scholarship will help support achieving these goals,
  - **d.** a copy of the Applicant's most recent high school transcript signed by the school's guidance counselor or principal.



### Payment of award to the successful Scholarship Recipient:

- **a.** Once proof of enrollment to the four-year college / university OR technical school program (as stated in their application) is received from the successful scholarship recipient, payment will be mailed shortly thereafter.
- **b.** This is a one-time scholarship award. Previous scholarship recipients are not eligible to receive additional amounts from this Scholarship Fund.
- **c.** Scholarship awards are not retroactive and may not be credited to semesters already completed.
- **d.** The successful applicant will be notified of their scholarship award in May 2023.
